VSY's stunning 72-metre packed with innovations

Without doubt one of the most extraordinary launches of 2012, Viareggio Superyachts' 72-metre continues to wow guests with her innovative touches. To walk through this yacht is to be continually surprised by her astonishing spaces and features. In the main salon, whose 2.7-metre height is enhanced by huge windows, a living vertical garden runs through the decks. The survival of the plants, sourced from Brazil, is ensured by a complex

environmental control system. The aft sundeck features twin hot-tubs and a certified helipad made for a Eurocopter 155. Design is by Espen Øino and naval architecture by Laurent Giles.
