**5 VSY, EXPLORER PROJECT**

Enrico Lumini and Michele Dragoni from Milan's Hot Lab studio have teamed up with the Viareggio yard to produce an idea that interprets traditional explorer yacht traits – the classic bow design and a “chunky” superstructure adapted from working boats or research vessels – in a stylish, modernist manner.

**6 SANLORENZO, M/Y SEVEN SINS**

Accommodating 12 guests in five cabins, this 52m semi-custom steel motor yacht has a plethora of leisure and entertainment facilities on board, including a glass-bottom pool and beach club with retractable platforms. With a cruising speed of 15kn, she is capable of a reaching a maximum 17kn.

**7 ROSSINAVI, M/Y AURORA**

Named after a spectacular natural phenomenon, the sporty 49m motor yacht has an imposing reputation to live up to, but she manages to do just that. Fulvio De Simoni's external lines are clean and pure, while the interior by Achille Salvagni has a custom-lighting system that helps Aurora to hit the heights.

**8 OCEANCO, PROJECT LUMEN**

Light is also a theme for a dazzling concept from the Dutch shipyard renowned for its 80m-plus builds. A glass and metal superstructure is encased in sculptured forms by California-based Adriel Designs. The extra flare is provided by shimmering surface, created using the groundbreaking Sun King Diamond Coating.
